This fund pays for all Township non-R&B expenses

- Professional Services: Town Attorney, Assessor, Audit / Accounting
- Insurance: Township, Property, Workman's Compensation, Unemployment Payment
- All Township buildings: Maintenance, repairs, cleaning
- Elections
- Telephone, internet service and utilities.
- Office supplies and postage.
- Township Recycling
- Cleanup Day
- Donations and Dues: Minnesota Association of Townships, CMRP, Monticello and Clearwater Libraries
- Playground

Road and Bridge Fund

This fund pays for all Township expenses related to Road and Bridge

- Wages, taxes, insurance and benefits for our road maintenance personnel.
- All expenses related to reconstruction or upgrades to existing roads.
- Professional Services: Engineer
- Road Maintenance: grading, gravel expenses, snow plowing, salt, sand, crack filling, asphalt patching
- ROW (right of way): mowing, brush removal, tree trimming, weed control
- Road Equipment: purchase, maintenance, repair, fuel
- Chloride for gravel stabilization & dust control, road signs, culverts and other related items.
- Shop supplies, equipment parts & supplies, oils, filters

Review of 2022

Road Improvements

- Asphalt Overlay
 - 143rd and Cushing
 - Bishop Ave.
- ChipSeal
 - Elder, Estes, 159th, Clementa, 127th, Armitage
 - Cancelled: Bishop and 156th St.
- All were roads as identified by the 2022 Engineer Street Study
 - Engineer 2022 Estimate: \$550,590
 - Not done: Barton 300', 156+CulDeSac
 - Township spent \$310,268.95

Road Maintenance

- Inslope/Ditch Work filling
- Chloride of gravel roads: 38,000 Gallons
 - 10,000 gallon increase from 2021
- Gravel Hauling: 7164 yards / Gravel Crushing: 14,026 tons
- 20,000 lbs of crack filling asphalt roads:
 - Covered approx. 1/3 of asphalt roads
- Normal road/ditch maintenance
- Gravel Pit Reclamation: None

Review of 2022

Township Hall Maintenance & Repairs

- Roof membrane on Town Hall.
- Gutters on North side of Hall to divert water leaking into HVAC.


New Accounting Method

- Cash to Accrual
 - State Statue Requirement when Township reaches Population / Revenue
 - Town Clerk Can't do much of the work previously done under Cash
 - Cost tripled in 2022 to implement
 - 2021: \$7,475 to 2022: \$22,790



Proposed Levy for 2024

For FY 2023, it will be a year of road maintenance, including asphalt overlays, gravel chip sealing, and crack filling, along with gravel production/hauling as the major expenditures.

The Board of Supervisors are requesting, \$1,260,000 to be approved by the residents of Silver Creek Township, for fiscal year 2024.

Recycling

The recycling contract could be reconsidered with West Central Sanitation when it ends December 2023. There is an increasing cost to this service, and it continues to go up. The recycling cost is estimated at \$58,000 FY2023. The town could consider having a recycling dumpster placed at the town hall and residents would bring their recyclables to the bins. This would substantially lower townships costs and remove your curbside recycling container.

General Fund Expenditures for 2024

The Board of Supervisors is requesting that Township Citizens approve expenditures of funds for memorials and recognitions, etc., and for lunch for workers at the annual Township cleanup day. The request is for a maximum of \$750.00 accumulated total for all such expenses for the year. This has been approved since 2014.

As required by law, this request must be approved by vote at the annual Township meeting.
