Clerk-Treasurer Report

- -Proposed Levy Certification forms were submitted with an increase of 3 percent for both funds in accordance with the annual meeting approval.

- -Chevrolet 1500 tire replacement was tabled due to the possibility of replacing the vehicle.
- -A hydraulic study is in the budget for 2025. Once completed the study should be good for 5 years. Estimates will be gathered for the study.
