-High and low priority overlay projects for next season were evaluated: 134th and Dempsey, 128th, 140th (west of co rd 8), 142nd and Dillon, Armitage (from 97th to 90th)

-Potential chip seal to be added to select asphalt and gravel roads: Bishop, 134th (dead end), 116th and Ferman, Franklin (dead end), 150th, 144th and Ellingwood, 105th and Amery.

-Compared asphalt vs chip seal in turnarounds, attendees questioned if asphalt has better integrity in turnarounds compared to chip seal.

-Discussion about the possibility of creating an ordinance pertaining to road damage, specifically due to unloading equipment on hard surface roadways.

-Plugged and failing culverts were evaluated, questions arose if the responsibility of certain driveway culverts falls on township or resident, will be discussed at future meetings.
