<u>Up the Creek – Rhineberger's response:</u> They do not have a CUP. It is operating as a pre-existing nonconforming use in the S3 and R1 zones, which means it is allowed to exist and continue operating. Any expansion or proposed expansion of the use would require review by the Board of Adjustment for an expansion of a nonconforming use.

<u>Fire Funds</u> – Discussion about when our contract is up for renewal with Monticello and to check on the rates for other Fire Departments (Maple Lake and Clearwater) to cover our Township. Question was asked if there are any legal ramifications on the distance from the firehouse. A resident said he thought Clearwater Fire Department was going to increase their fire calls by \$100 and this is larger than Maple Lake or Monticello. Clerk Urbatch will look into the renewal date with Monticello.
