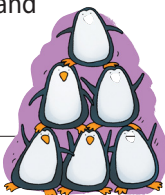

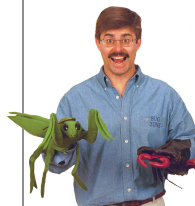
The Dollipops!
