Employees from the Wright County Assessor's Office are available to assist property owners in understanding their Notice of Valuation and Classification, and to address any concerns regarding the values and classification for the 2020 Assessment, Property Taxes Payable in 2021.

Wright County appraisers will continue to work with property owners to resolve any appeals using all tools available to them with the exception of face to face interaction.
