Registration for Art Exhibit March 1 – March 30

Artists who wish to enter their work in the exhibit will complete a registration form and send it to AWAAC by no later than March 30, 2019. Artists may enter no more than two (2) pieces of art work. All media are welcome including, but not limited to paintings, photography, sculpture, ceramics, pottery, glass, fiber arts, wooden and metal work. There is no fee to participate but prior registration is required.

April 1 or April 2 Art Work Drop Off

Participating artists must drop their work off at the Waterville Branch Library on either April 1 or 2 between the hours of 4:30 pm and 7:30 pm. Representatives from AWAAC will be at the library to take care of the entries beginning at 4:30 pm on April 1 and April 2. Artists will complete an entry form that includes artist contact information, medium used, title of art work/s, and price if the work is for sale. Artists may enter no more than two (2) pieces of art work. A card with the artist's name, title of the work and price if it is for sale will be placed next to each work. AWAAC will take care of installing the work.

If artists cannot drop their work off at the library on April 1 or 2 they should contact Lisa Exner at 567-686-6921 or exner@bex.net to make other arrangements. We want as many local artists to participate as possible and are willing to help everyone who is interested be part of this show.

April 1 - April 30 Exhibit Dates

Art work will be on display at the library beginning on April 1 or 2 through April 30. The public will be invited to stop in the library during regular hours to view the work. The exhibit will be promoted through the AWAAC website, E-news, Facebook and media releases. Artists will be encouraged to help with this promotion through their Facebook pages, websites, etc.

April 16 Artists' Reception

All participating artists, their family and friends will be invited to attend an open house reception at the library to be held on April 16 from 6:00 to 7:30 pm. in Meeting Room A. This will be an informal reception and people can drop in anytime during the designated hours.

May 1 - May 4 Artists pick up art work

At the conclusion of the exhibit artists will pick up their work during regular library hours from May 1 - 4. If artists have not picked up their work by May 4, AWAAC will contact them to expedite the process and make other arrangements to return art work if necessary.

General Information

The Anthony Wayne Area Arts Commission will take the upmost care when displaying all art work entered in the exhibit. Participating artists will be required to sign a liability waiver.

No art work can be sold on the premises of the library. However, signage will be displayed explaining who they will need to contact if someone is interested in purchasing a piece of art work from the show.

This is not a juried show and there are no awards connected to the exhibit. The displayed art work is intended to demonstrate the talent of our many local artists and to raise the awareness about these artists. It is also meant to engage the public in the art work by careful viewing of the work.
