The UDA did express support in working out an agreement with the District should additional funds be needed after bid quotes are received. Olver Associates have updated the projected project cost to \$18.5 M. 2018 Dodge Truck, The manager reported it would not be cost effective to accept the monies from the insurance company for repairs to the damaged truck, sell off the truck as is and

purchase a new truck, to expedite the trucks replacement. The Manager suggested repairing the Truck and trading it in upon repair as that would double its value as a trade in.
