## Updates;

#### WWTP;

Manager reports that the contract with Apex Construction to award the bid for the WWTP upgrades was signed off last week. Board requested a start date and schedule as soon as possible.

#### Main St. Project;

Manager reported that there were 4 services left on the old 6" main that needed to be transferred to the 12" main but the MEDOT shut down any more digging in the roadway for winter preparations. It was unfortunate these 4 services could not be worked on as it would of allowed the 6" main to be capped and abandoned back to Seawall Rd. before winter set in. There were already 7 leaks in the old 6" main during the construction project.

After discussion the Board asked the District Manager to relay to Verizon Wireless that they do not desire to own the antenna nor be involved with permitting and maintenance. They were in favor of leasing the property though.

## Workers Comp;

The Manager reported that Workers Comp declined to reimburse the District for the Managers travel expenses and time off. Manager got in touch with a State Mediator to try and push MMA for reimbursement.
