## **PROVEN PERFORMANCE**



WDi was tasked with redesigning and constructing an addition to the IPS #49 William Penn Cafeteria. The project involved enlarging the dining hall and kitchen area to reduce the number of daily serving times from six to two. WDi provided a comprehensive range of services, including programming, planning, design, and construction administration. The project team, led by WDi, successfully oversaw the S1.2 Million building renovation and addition. The work included expanding the cafeteria by 1,045 square feet and renovating an additional 1,035 square feet. Overall, WDi delivered exceptional performance in managing the production team and completing the project successfully.

This project involved dealing with a historic landmark building that was almost a century old. Despite its apparent simplicity as a four-story building, it was actually quite intricate. Each floor contained multiple levels, with six different levels on the main floor alone. The building structure posed a significant challenge, with columns changing from concrete to steel at different levels, and deep steel trusses embedded in some interior walls. Nevertheless, the project team successfully managed the complex design and construction, delivering the project within the S14,000,000.00 budget. CMC at Risk Delivery was utilized for the project, enabling the team to overcome the challenges and complete the project successfully.





The exceptional performance of the Indianapolis Airport has earned it the title of the best airport in North America and WDi Architecture, Inc. collaborated with six African-American architectural firms located in Indianapolis to establish Architects Consortium, L.L.C., with the goal of collectively pursuing the Airport Ground Transportation Center (GTC) projects. The parking facility consists of six levels, providing parking for 5,900 public vehicles on the top four levels and accommodating 1,200 rental vehicles for Rental Automobile Company (RAC) activities on the ground level. The second level is exclusively reserved for hourly parkers, while the third through sixth levels serve as daily parking areas.
