

site information for any changes or additions. Also, you never need an excuse to visit. We highly recommend regular visits!



Annual Dues/Membership Renewal Deadline March 6th – Don't be late!

Members were mailed the renewal form via regular mail in mid-December 2018. Forms are also available at the Club and on the web site. Due to the By-Law change to increase annual dues, <u>the</u> <u>Board of Directors extended the payment</u> <u>deadline until NLT March 6, 2019</u>. Members are asked to put their payment with the renewal form in an envelope and deposit it in the box provided at the Gerry or mail to the Gerry with payment and mark the envelope as "DUES" or "MEMBERSHIP".

Members who plan to make an extra donation, are reminded that donations to the Gerry 5 may not be tax deductible and should check with their tax preparer before doing so.

Members who do not pay their dues by the March 6th cutoff date will be "read out" and no longer be members in good standing. You will lose all membership privileges and your key cards will be deactivated. Should you decide to rejoin you will have to go through the steps of a new applicant (except orientation) and pay the \$150.00 application fee (includes annual dues).
