Bill called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and moved to accept the agenda as presented and to pay bills. Tom seconded, Vote 3-0.

The Commission realized that an error has occurred in the payroll regarding the pay of the Presiding Commissioner. According to Missouri Statutes 49.082 and 50.327, the Presiding Commissioner is to be paid \$2000 annually more than the Associate Commissioners.

Kenneth Turpin and Rich Gores requested maintenance on County Road 304. The Commission will discuss options with the Road and Bridge Department.

Beth White and Marla Reid met with the Commission regarding health insurance for county employees. The premiums have gone up significantly. Under the Affordable Care Act, they have been negotiated down to a 21% increase from a 26% increase. No other providers quoted the county's health insurance,

The Commission held an elected officials meeting at 10:00 AM. Ballot and election issues were discussed. The Christmas gathering for the county was planned.

A Salary Commission meeting was held at 11:00 AM. Separate minutes were taken for this meeting.


There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until November 6, 2025, at 9:00 AM
