
The Commission went into CLOSED SESSION from 9:30 AM – 10:30 AM, per RSMo 610.021.1.

Brenda Miller met with the Commission regarding liability insurance coverage and MoPerm coverages. Brenda will submit a claim on behalf of the county.


There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until April 10, 2025 at 9:00 AM.
