The Commission met with Ameren gas on the pipeline installation. No concerns were expressed by either party at this time.

John Deere presented a road grader purchase order for signatures per the bid opening held previously. The grader is ordered, and the county expects delivery around June.

The Commission met with Billy Orf, Road and Bridge Supervisor, regarding projects in the county. County Road 310 was discussed. Couty Roads 139, 318, 476, 280, and 291 are being researched for repairs soon.

Tom moved to accept Premier Pest Solutions for the coming year for Pike County premises pest control. Brock seconded. Vote 3-0.

Alex Ellison, Pike County Prosecuting Attorney, met with and reported on a contract for Child Welfare. Changes are needed and caused by contractual issues beyond the county's control. Services will be offered within the county and a small reimbursement is available from the State. The Commission agreed to the contract and the Presiding Commissioner signed the documents provided by Ellison. Brock moved to accept the Prosecutor's recommendation. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Wisecarver, Pike County Development Authority, reported on a local business concern. The railroad has not contracted any involved party concerning the pedestrian bridge approval.

Garrett Cizek, A&A Security Services reported on the transition of services for the current security contract. The paperwork will be in place in the very near future, as they will provide a contract, liability insurance, and uniform documents for the Clerk within a few days.

The Cohran Engineering bill for CR 227 bridge was presented and recommended by Bill Allen to pay from ARPA funds, totaling \$1495.11. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.
