Bill Allen called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM and moved to accept the agenda as presented and pay bills. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

The Commission met with Billy Orf, Road and Bridge Supervisor and discussed multiple projects going on in the county. The Louisiana walking bridge was discussed, and a used guardrail will be placed on site. Frankford needs Road and Bridge to assist on a project but waiting on the Army Corp of Engineers to grant a permit. Road conditions seem to be improving throughout the county, and graders continue to operate through their routes. No new applicants have inquired about Road and Bridge employment.


Bill moved to communicate with Frankford that the county be willing to assist in the installation of the culvert on Frankford Street (S. Main Cross) pending the proof of line location and Army Corp of Engineers permits. Brock seconded. Vote 3-0.

Bill spoke with Tary Todd, Cochran Engineering, regarding County Road 227 Bridge project. Windstream needs to move poles and has not responded to Tary Todd with details. Tom spoke with Windstream on behalf of the County and Cochran.

Olivia Ledford, Pike County Treasurer, reported on the monthly sales tax revenue for the county and reported that the CD's matured but recommended that they remain invested with their current provider with no changes to the CD investments for the short term. Brock moved to follow her recommendations. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Bill asked the Records Office to seek the ownership of properties associated with the County Road 227 Bridge.
