Commission met with Billy Orf, Road & Bridge Supervisor, discussed the degradation and weight restrictions on bridges after recent reviews. The County will attempt to make repairs, at a minimum, to permit local traffic.

Commission completed audit questionnaires. They are for the 2023 audit that is underway.

Commission met with Kaitlyn Niemeyer, she is seeking support for grant applications to improve the safety at county railroad crossings.

Commission met with Ameren regarding the gas line project (Phase 1). Road issues during Phase 1 were discussed, the roads will be examined to determine whether the County will release Ameren from Phase 1 liability. Phase 2 will go from Ashely to Silex from January 2025 to May 2025.

Commission inspected a bridge on CR439.

There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until October 24, 2024, at 9:00am.




