Bill called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and moved to accept the agenda as presented and to pay bills. Tom seconded, Vote 3-0.

The Commission met with Billy Orf, Road and Bridge Supervisor and discussed projects and needs in the county. We discussed Railroad signs that have not yet been delivered. County Road 458 is nearly completed, and the backhoe needs repair from CAT. Remote fuel tanks near grader storage site were discussed and being researched.

The Commission spoke with Kelly Crane, Pike County Assessor, regarding a Missouri State Tax Commission issue.

Bill moved to go into Closed Session per RSMO 610.021.1. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Wisecarver, Pike County Development Authority, delivered documents and the Commission signed the contractor the award for the Bowling Green Pedestrian Bridge and to deny the bids for the adjacent sidewalks. Possible re-bidding in the future as bids were more than the engineering design and specifications.

Laura Stumbaugh, Pike County Clerk, met with the Commission at 10:00 AM for the scheduled and advertised Amended Budget Hearing. No additional patrons were in attendance. The Fine Fund needs to be amended to increase revenue by \$269,501.05. The Election Fund needs to be amended by \$3000 for Revenue. Laura also spoke with the Commission regarding the 2026 budget.

The fines must, and have been, be paid to the county schools.

The election fund revenues will be spent on training.

Brock moved to amend the budget to reflect the above recommendations. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until November 6, 2025, at 9:00 AM
