Bill called the Commission to order and recommended paying the bills. Brock seconded. Vote 2-0. Tom Wallace was not in Attendance, but available via telephone.



KEE Painting was contacted and agreed to meet the week of March 9<sup>th</sup> to discuss plaster repair and painting in the courthouse.


Charles Hopke was contacted to look at a door repair to the courtroom. He is going to attempt the repairs and keep the historical and architectural value of the doors.
