ORDINANCE NO. 2004 A

AN ORDINANCE TO RELINQUISH AUTHORITY TO PIKE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, HOME CARE AND HOSPICE TO ENFORCE ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS UPON ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCE FOR THAT PURPOSE BY PIKE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, HOME CARE AND HOSPICE.

WHEREAS, Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice is an independent governmental entity in Pike County, Missouri authorized by Section 205.010 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri to enact and enforce ordinances, rules and regulations as will tend to enhance the public health and prevent the entrance of infectious, contagious, communicable or dangerous diseases into Pike County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, an ordinance rules and regulations dealing with on-site sewage disposal systems promulgated by Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice will further the public health goals of Pike County, Missouri.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission of Pike County, Missouri that their authority under Ordinance 2001 A and B be rescinded with authority assumed by Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice to enforce Ordinance 2001 A and B until such time an ordinance is passed by Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice to exercise their authority. This ordinance shall become effective on the date that this ordinance is acted upon and ordered by the Pike County Commission.
