Bill moved to acquire the services of McBride, Lock and Associates, LLC to complete the audit of the county for 2027. The document/contract is dated August 19, 2026. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Charlie Chapius met with the Commission to discuss a RR bridge project. Charlie met on behalf of Dave Peters, a landowner that will have substantial disruption to farm activity.

Kylie Andersen and Sara Riggins met to discuss local youth activities. Sara is new to the county and the local Youth 4H Program Associate.

Watt Walker, Hutchinson Engineering met and discussed the Frankford sidewalk project. The Bowling Green pedestrian bridge project was also discussed. In addition the County Road 33 bridge project and the Right of way issue was discussed. Matt will send documents to the Fisher family.

Bill moved to adopt Ordinance #03-2026 to establish a procedure to disclose potential conflicts of interest and substantial interest for certain officials. Brock seconded. Vote 3-0.
