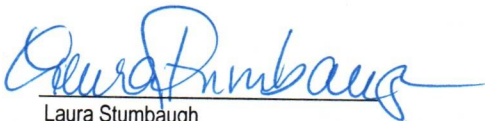
Bill called the Commission to order and moved to pay the bills. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Billy Orf, Road and Bridge Supervisor, met with the Commission and discussed local projects. County Road 123 has become more heavily traveled due to the Highway B bridge replacement by MoDOT. The Commission discussed options. Brock moved to allow Road and Bridge to determine length of dust control on County Road 123, and to dust control from Highway 61 outer road to County Road 125 due to excessive traffic as it had become a local detour. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

Bill moved to purchase a 2020 Ford Explorer from Poage Ford for \$26,199.00. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0. The purchase was made based on quotes from both local county new automobile dealerships.

Kelly Crane, Pike County Assessor met and discussed a late fee issue. The Commission informed Crane that the county policy is to not waive late fees except in extraordinary circumstances, and according to Crane nonexistent in this situation.

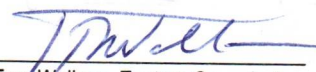
The meeting was adjourned, with the next meeting being July 9, 2026 at 9:00 AM.



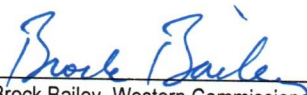
