Commission met with Don Schlueter, Janitor:

*Discussed courthouse cleanliness and expectations. He is going to document the locations that need plaster repairs. The 3rd floor has an electrical issue that will need to be addressed. Breaks were also discussed.

The Commission inspected the 3rd floor electrical concern. The Commission went to the Annex the inspect current repairs being done to roof. Repairs should be completed the week of June 24th.
