Bill called the Commission to order and moved to pay the bills. Tom seconded. Vote 2-0.

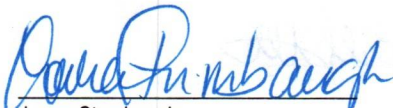

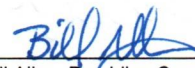
A resident on Pike 218 came in and asked if we would look at the road where it washed out. Bill will call Billy Orf and have him take a look.
