

Ordinance 11-6B

Whereas, the County Commissioners of Pike is hereby amending ordinance 11-6A to include additional (NAICS) codes to include those companies which operate in Missouri under the North American Industry Classification Codes (NAICS). The amended clusters should add to the existing and include:

- 11 Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting
- 21 Mining
- 22 Utilities
- 23 Construction
- 31-33 Manufacturing
- 42 Wholesale Trade
- 48-49 Transportation and Warehousing
- 51 Information
- 52 Finance and Insurance
- 53 Real Estate, Rental and Leasing
- 54 Professional, Scientific and Technical Services
- 55 Management of Companies and Enterprises
- 56 Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services
- 62 Healthcare and Social Assistance
- 71 Art, Entertainment and Recreation, excluding 7132-Gaming Operations
- 81 Other Services, excluding 8131-Religious Institutions or

The business' activities within the Zone produce value-added agricultural products as defined in RSMo. § 348.015 (14).

Headquarters or administrative offices of an otherwise excluded business may qualify for benefits if the offices serve a multistate territory. Service industries may be eligible only if a majority of its annual revenues will be derived from out of state.


Conflict of Interest Ordinance

June 6, 2016


Whereas, the Conflict of Interest for Pike County, Missouri must be renewed no later than September 15th, 2016, in order for the ordinance to remain in effect; the Pike County Commission meets today, June 6th to renew this ordinance as follows:

Only the Chief Purchasing Officer (County Clerk), the Chief Administrative Officer (Presiding Commissioner) and any elected official or employee who has had a transaction of more than \$500.00 with Pike County are required to complete the Personal Financial Disclosure to be sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission.




