## PIKE COUNTY ORDINANCE <u>02-11</u> AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE PROVISIONS OF 488.5026, RSMO.

Pursuant to the authority of 488.5026, RSMo, the Pike County Commission enacts this Ordinance to assess costs for the purposes authorized by that statute.

A surcharge of two dollars (\$2.00) shall be assessed as costs in each court proceeding filed in the Circuit Court of Pike County, Missouri, in all criminal cases including violations of any county ordinance or any violation of criminal or traffic laws of the State, including infractions; and matters certified from the Municipal Division for hearing by a circuit or associate circuit judge; except that no such fees shall be collected in any proceeding when the proceeding or the defendant has been dismissed by the court or when costs are to be paid by the State of County. A surcharge of two dollars (\$2.00) shall be assessed as costs in a juvenile court proceeding in which a child is found by the court to come within the applicable provisions of subdivision (3) of subsection 1 of section 211.031, RSMo.

The moneys collected by clerks of the courts pursuant to the provisions of the Ordinance shall be collected and disbursed in accordance with sections 488.010 to 488.020, and shall be payable to the Treasurer of Pike County.

The Treasurer of Pike County shall deposit funds generated by this Ordinance into the "Inmate Security Fund." Funds deposited shall be utilized to develop biometric identification systems to insure that inmates can be properly identified and tracked within the Pike county Detention Center. Once installed, this fund may be used for maintenance of the biometric verification system, and to pay any expenses related to custody and housing and other expenses for prisoners.

This Ordinance is accepted and enacted by the undersigned Pike County Commissioners and shall become enforceable immediately upon its enactment this 28 day of February, 2011.
