November 4, 1999- Ordinance NO. 11499- Ordinance Prohibiting Burning In The County of Pike, State of Missouri

COMES NOW The County of Pike, State of Missouri, by and through the duly elected County Commission, and hereby order, decree, and ordain the following:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn trash, leaves, debris, rubbish, or vegetation outside of a burn container within the County of Pike, State of Missouri, from and after and date of this ordinance until further action is deemed necessary by the County Commission of Pike County, Missouri.
- 2. This ordinance shall specifically exclude any persons within the city limits of any municipal corporation contained within the County of Pike, State of Missouri.
- 3. Any violation of this ordinance shall be prosecuted in the Associate Circuit Court of Pike County, Missouri, which shall have original jurisdiction. Violations of this ordinance are punishable by a fine not less than \$1.00, not to exceed \$500.00.
- 4. This ordinance shall become law and be effective from and after its date of passage.
- 5. Read two times and passed by unanimous vote of the full Commission.

December 6, 1999- NOTICE: As of this date the Pike County Commission of Pike County Missouri have lifted the **Burning Ban for Pike County**.

December 8, 1998- **ORDINANCE NO. 1063** An ordinance annexing certain property owned by the State of Missouri; County of Pike; Charlene C. McCune and Tapley McCune; Shirley M. Forgy and Charles C. Forgy; and Velma Birkhead into the City of Bowling Green, Missouri and amending the city zoning district maps and Chapter 42 of the Bowling Green, Missouri City Code to provide the zoning of said property as Industrial (B-1) pursuant to their petition seeking voluntary annexation pursuant to Section 71.012 *RSMo*.
