

July 26, 2004- NOW ON THIS DAY, The Commission renewed the **Conflict of Interest Ordinance** which is necessary to be reviewed every two years. The ordinance required the Chief Purchasing Officer (Pike County Clerk) and the Chief Administrative Officer (Presiding Commissioner) and any elected official or employee who has had a transaction of more than \$500 with Pike County to file a personal financial disclosure to the Missouri Ethics Commission. Vote was (3-0) (See Conflict of Interest File)

May 24, 2004- NOW ON THIS DAY, the Commission approved **Ordinance M-1** which allows the Cannon Water Supply District No. 1 of Ralls, Monroe and Marion Counties rights to install and maintain a water pipeline in and along the following county roads:

PIKE 20, 22, 23, and 26.

ORDER M-1

Now on this 24th day of May, 2004 comes on for hearing the petition of Cannon Water Supply District No. 1 of Ralls, Monroe and Marion Counties, Missouri for permission and authority to install and maintain a water pipe line in and along the public roads which are designated for each incidence of construction of the water line within the district boundaries, to facilitate the furnishing of water to the residents of said district.

And the Commission having carefully considerate said petition, and having heard the evidence in support thereof, and being fully advised in the premises, find that the allegations of said petition are true, and that said water district is entitled to the relief prayed for.

It is here fore order, adjudged and decreed that the water district be, and hereby is, authorized to install and maintain a water pipeline in and along the public roads described in the first paragraph hereof, subject however, to the following rules and regulations:

1. That said water district repair and restore said County Road to its original condition following the installation of any maintenance work on said water pipe line:
2. That such installation and maintenance be conducted and preformed in such manner and at such time as not unreasonable to interrupt or interfere with the normal flow of traffic upon said County Road:
3. That such water pipe installed in said road at a sufficient dept as not to interfere in any way with the maintenance thereof:
4. That such water pipe be installed on County shoulder, and not in the traveled portion of road, except to cross road to get to the other side.
5. It is to be fully understood by both parties, that during construction and until the road is duly repaired, Ralls County is not to be held responsible.
6. The foregoing petition said and ordered has been fully examined by the Ralls County Commission and the same hereby is approved by Commission, and spread on the records of the Ralls County Commission in the County Commission Recorded _____ at _____ page.
