The Commission met with Carolyn Wisecarver, Pike County Development Authority, to discuss multiple projects happening in the county.

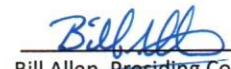

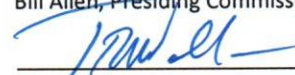
There being no further business, the Commission adjourned for the morning and will resume with the Board of Equalization meeting beginning at 1:00 PM today.

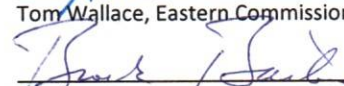
There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until July 24, 2025 at 9:00 AM.
