Bill called the Commission to order at 9:00 AM and moved to pay the bills. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.



Billy Orf, Road and Bridge Supervisor met and discussed local road issues. Bill moved to dust control County Road 219 in 2026 only, due to recent repairs to the road. Future dust control will be the responsibility of the County Road 219 residents. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0. MoDOT is replacing the Ramsey Creek bridge and an increase in local traffic is anticipated. Bill moved to make a one-time minor repair at the union of Mississippi Street in Clarksville and County Road 239. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0. Future repairs will be the property owners responsibility.

Judge Jim Beck, Judge Milan Berry and Circuit Clerk Kathy Turner met and recommended furnishings for the 2nd and 3rd floor courtrooms. Tom moved to accept the quote for approximately \$5500 to be paid with money from Capital Improvements. Bill seconded. Vote 3-0.

Lori Smith, MoDOT, assisted the Commission with the FFATA paperwork. The form was completed, signed by the Commission and submitted.
