Commission was notified that water meters should start being installed on Pike 136 & Pike 137.

The Commission discussed the plans for moving materials from the 1^{st} floor of the Annex to the 2^{nd} floor in order to make room for the Recorder's historical records. This should happen Thursday, 6/27/24 with the assistance of county employees.

The Commission discussed the Ameren Solar Project scheduled to start in the third quarter of 2024. The City of Bowling Green has voted to allow the county to negotiate the Chapter 100 plan on their behalf for the portion of the project that is in city limits. No decisions were made, currently waiting on legal counsel.

The Commission met with Larry Chamberlain, representing Pike County Memorial Hospital. State Representative Chad Perkins was also in attendance. Larry discussed the needs of the hospital. It was noted that the State and Federal Medicaid and Medicare are delinquent in payments and have been since 2019 for approximately \$1,600,000. No decisions were made, however the county and the hospital will continue to seek funding possibilities.
