Bill Allen called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and moved to accept the agenda as presented and pay bills. Brock seconded; Vote 3-0.

Tom reported on the Northeast Commissioner's and Clerk's meeting that met on September 9, 2025.

Raymond Abel met with the commission regarding CR 246 / Valley View Drive. The Commission agreed that County Roads that are "improved" by the adjacent property owners must continue to maintain the "improved" roads to meet county specifications and standards. If an "improved" road falls into disrepair, the county reserves the authority to maintain to county standards and the property owners, and the road improvement petitioners lose authority over the road until deemed appropriate by the County Commission. The County may elect to maintain any road as it deems appropriate including returning it to gravel. The County will continue to provide snow removal, but potential damage is the responsibility of the "improvement" petitioners. The County Commission produced a template to be used for individuals to "improve" county roads. Tom moved to permit Mr. Raymond Abel to work on CR 236. Bill seconded; vote 3-0. Document was signed by all parties.

The Commission met with Jim Meyer, Kiley Anderson, and Chris Nation about the YPA salary for the end of fiscal year 2025. Brock moved to pay Kiley Anderson salary until the end of 2025. Bill seconded; vote 3-0. Funds are from Salary line Extension budget.

The Commission spoke with Eddie Heffner, Frankford council member, via telephone about roads in Frankford. The Commission will talk with Billy Orf about possibilities.

The Commission met with Kelly Crane, newly sworn-in Pike County Assessor, and discussed office space changes and adjusting to the elected position.

Bill Sterne met with the Commission and personally invited each to the grand opening of the new 911 building on September 18, 2025.
