Bill Allen called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM and moved to accept the agenda as presented and pay bills. Tom seconded. Vote 3-0.

The Commission discussed recent complaints about increased trash from the trash delivery trucks going to the landfill. It is believed that the landfill and Meridian waste do well in controlling trash on their site, but the delivery companies and truck drivers must do better. We contacted Meridian and plan to contact law enforcement regarding littering citations.

Tom moved to pay Cochran \$7,477.54 from ARPA funds for the CR 227 bridge project. Brock seconded. Vote 3-0.

Road and Bridge Supervisor Billy Orf presented two bids for removal and installation of security fence at the County Shed. Wilhoit Farms and Ivan Eicher bid the project. Commission voted 3-0 to accept the Eicher Bid. Orf to contact and set up project timing with successful bidder.

Matt Walker with Hutchison Engineering presented a request for obligation of preliminary engineering funds for BRO-R082 (003), Bridge 07800031 to the Commission. All Commissioners signed off on the project.




The Commission secured the services of Greg's Glass/Corey Orf to repair the broken glass pane in the Recorder's office and to attempt to repair the mechanism on the windows in the Collector's office. Vote 3-0. The window project was completed by a different contractor that is no longer in business. The Commission appreciates Corey advising and making the necessary repairs.

The Commission reported to Travis Elliott regarding documents needed to complete the Ameren Chapter 100 Solar Project. The Commission is appreciative of Travis and his legal team's expertise as they assist in guiding the county through the process.

The Commission attempted to contact Ithaca Farms ownership about the construction of CR 227 bridge. Cochran Engineering has requested assistance with the adjacent landowners.

There being no other business before the County Commission, the meeting adjourned until April 7, 2025 at 9:00 AM.
