Bill and Brock reported on the Hwy 54 meeting that was held on July 15, 2026 in Vandalia. The meeting was to determine the future scope, and the next steps to proceed with the Mark Twain Regional Council of Governments, MoDOT and the Build grant.

The Commission discussed the future site for the Cancer Memorial. Currently, the County does not have the resources to dig, haul and prepare the site, as multiple major road projects are underway, and the department is understaffed.

The Commission contacted Mike Schafer, BNSF Railroad regarding the construction of a new bridge over Salt River in Northeast Pike County near the Mississippi River.

Sheriff Korte met with the Commission to discuss a grant. Bill signed the appropriate documentation.

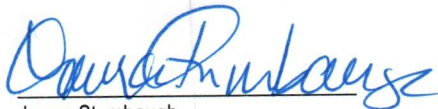
The Commission discussed County Road 124 concerns during the Route B Bridge replacement.

The next meeting will be July 20, 2026 at 9:00 AM.



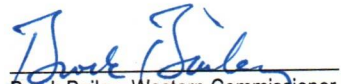
