Commission met with Billy Orf, R&B Supervisor, regarding the roads and the fact they will need much needed attention as the frost leaves. Graders and rock trucks are active now and will be operating as long as the conditions permit.

Commission discussed the security situation at the courthouse, as Lingle is going out of business. Security options will be sought and discussed before long-term decisions will be made. Lingle will continue until the last business day in March.

Bill Allen completed the wall in the lounge. It will serve as an office for Holly Leverenz, Coroner, temporarily. The County has not provided office space in recent years, however, it has been recently determined that the position is full-time and office space and vehicle will be provided.

Commission contacted Jeff Banderet, Great River Engineering, regarding CR251 bills received from PWSD #1 for reimbursement. They need guidance to determine the appropriate fund for payment. They are awaiting a response.


Commission met with Ollis, Akers and Arney, insurance and business advisors. Jeff Chronister and Bill Budnick represented the firm to discuss risk management.
