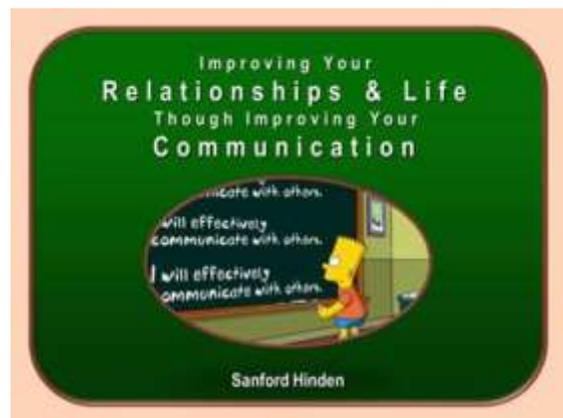
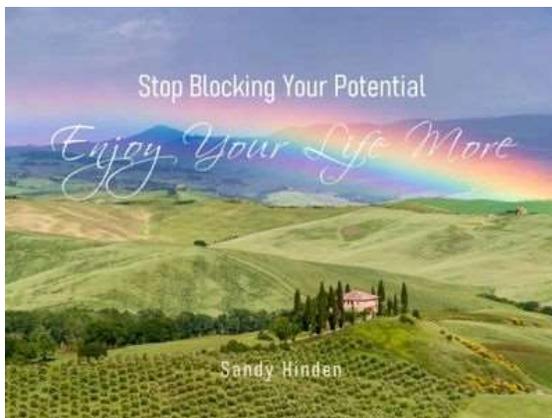
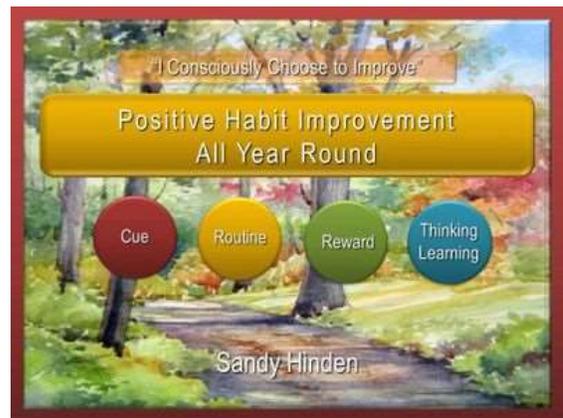
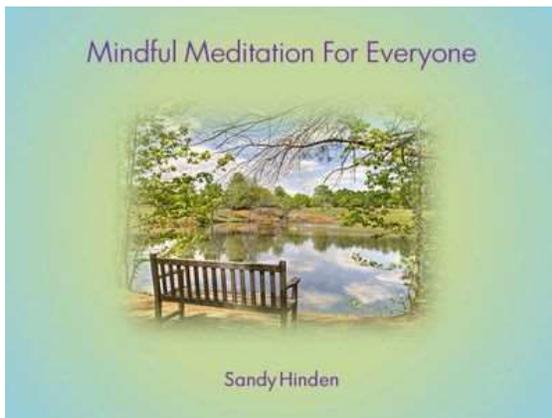
LOCAL EXPERIENCE
