



40 CHURCHES UNITED IN ONE PURPOSE

WHAT DO YOU DO?

Many folks within our churches really have no idea what exactly is an Association. Many have different questions as to its overall purpose and function. Hopefully, in this brief article, I can help address some of these.

First of all, what is an Association? Someone has written, "A Baptist association is a self-governing fellowship of autonomous churches sharing a common faith and active on mission in their setting". The Association is created by the churches for the churches. The Association is comprised of churches who are motivated to work together for the advancement of the Gospel in their local geographical setting. Just like members of a family, the Association is a culmination of churches that have different characteristics but share the same culture of trust and cooperation in working together for the expansion of the Kingdom.

Second of all, what does an Association do? The most obvious answer to that is found in the word "association". Association means that even though churches are autonomous (self-governing, self-sustaining, etc.), we join together for a work that a single church can't do on its own strength. A perfect example of this type of cooperation - if a single church can dig a pretty good-sized hole with one shovel, then how big of a hole could forty churches dig if they had focused determination on one singe hole? Even though each church has independence, God never intended His churches to exist and function in a vacuum. Our **independence** is even greater when we realize our need of **interdependence** on each other.

Some of the things which we have planned, and are planning to do in future, involve those areas that are designed to help our churches reach towards and maintain a healthy posture. For example, on April 4th, we had an Associational-wide Sunday School Training, in which we had thirteen (13) churches represented. Also, being planned for the late summer or early fall is a Church Financial workshop for all of our churches. However, the main focus of the Association is that of the pastor and their families.

When pastors and their families are healthy, then their churches are more than likely to be healthy. The opposite is true also, when the pastor and his family are unhealthy, the church is likely to be unhealthy. This is not always the case, but this is usually the case. So, the Association (our UCBA) has total pastor wellness as its top ministerial priority. This is why we helped facilitate the Pastor's Wives Annual Fellowship. We want to pour into the wives of our pastors because they carry more things than most of us realize, and they matter greatly. Healthy pastors and healthy pastor's wives will allow us to help cultivate a church that will be healthy for the future.

Next, how does the Association function? The Association has its own Constitution and By-Laws. It has its own organizational structure with Committees, Teams, etc. The main Committee is the Executive Committee (it consists of every pastor and one at-large member from every one of our churches). The Association also sets its own budget -it is solely funded by the ministry dollars that are given by and through the churches that associate together. It has its own staff. In the end, every aspect of the Association has incorporated members from it cooperating churches from top to bottom. Again, the Association is created by the churches for the churches.

Lastly, how can you support the Association? Here is the answer.....simply be involved in the church in which you attend. If you are in a church, then you have the power to make sure that your church works with your other sister churches. When the churches unite and come together for the Gospel, there is nothing that can stop her! Nothing, however, but an unwillingness to work together! Just remember.....
