After Hours Usage of the Club: Attention all after hours members and school shooting teams: For safety and security reasons, Pinetucky needs to know who is on the grounds at all time. Please make sure you are signing in on the After Hours Sign In sheets located on the Rifle/Pistol Ranges, Low House 2 for Shotgun Sports (sporting clays shooters, please sign in here also). Competition Bay shooters, please sign in on the rifle range sheets. If you are an after hours member you should have the codes and keys to enable you to sign in. Also if you are an instructor that has access to the competition bays, please make sure we have a current copy of your credentials and insurance policy that allows you access.

As a reminder all after hours shooters are responsible for cleaning up when done shooting. Please roll up cords, pick up your shells and load houses and turn off machines on skeet/trap fields. If you have the lights on, please turn those off also. Rifle/pistol range shooters please make sure your target stands are brought in, your brass is cleaned up and placed in the brass bucket and the brooms are hung up and the fans turned off. The lights are on timers, please do not force turn them off. They shut themselves off.

If you come to shoot while the clubhouse is open, please come to the clubhouse and sign in on the sheets at the office.
