Reminders: There have been a few concerns brought to our attention regarding range use. There are still some members that are leaving target stands out at night after they shoot. Also, just a reminder you must be shooting approved targets in the competition bays. If you have something round it must be placed against the back berm to prevent ricochet of the bullet elsewhere on the property. When that bullet leaves the bay and ricochets elsewhere, we do not know how far it will travel. I have personally heard them hit the steel buildings where we store the clay targets, and thankfully they hit the roof and do not go any further. Right past these steel buildings are the skeet/trap fields and we do not want to harm fellow shooters. Also, we are closing the windows on the skeet houses. If you are an after-hours shooter using the fields, please shut the windows when you leave. We appreciate your help in keeping Pinetucky running smoothly.
