2 Jan. Steel Shoot

Steel shooting offers a port of entry to the shooting sports that is far less intimidating than practical shooting. Steel provides an excellent starting place for young or beginning shooters. Steel offers the most diversified shooting sport out there, making it appealing to youth and seniors, novice and experts. Any practical handgun, including 22 rimfire (both handgun and rifle). Sign up starts at 9AM. Cost for monthly club level matches are \$10 for Pinetucky Club Members and \$15 for non-members. A second firearm can be registered for an additional \$5. Standard Pinetucky safety rules apply.

2 Jan. NRA Basic Rifle Course

The goal of NRL22 is to make Tactical Rifle more available to every community. The NRL22 understands that the shooting community is fascinated with Precision Rifle, but most local ranges do not have 1000 yard capacity. NRL22 brings Long Range Tactical Rifle to your local 100 yard range. For more information, go to NRL22.org. Cost will be \$20. **Rifle Range will be closed for this event**.

What is NRL.22?

A gateway to precision long rifle competitions such as the NRL or PRS. Designed to be extremely fun for beginners and seasoned shooters alike. This is a very youth friendly competition as well! Match fee will only be \$25.

This is a "Match in a can" where each months match we will be competing against competitors all over the country. There are monthly prize drawings held for NRL.22 members who competed that month. (Membership not required to shoot!)

Targets will be steel, each stage will have required shooting positions (i.e 2 shots at target A then B from the first rung of a ladder, repeat for rungs 2 and 3). Speed and accuracy are both important in this competition.

What is needed to compete?

A .22Ir rifle with a detachable magazine

A scope that will permit you to engage targets at various distances (My preference is a scope with MIL hashmarks, but any scope that gives you the ability to shoot various distances will work)

Bipod

Other equipment that would be nice would be a shooting bag like a mini gamechanger, sling, DOPE card, binos, Spotting scope, ballistic calculator app, etc. There is NO NEED to go buy a bunch of gear before your first match, plenty of people will be there to lend out gear.

Loaner rifles are available as well!

16 Jan. NRA Pistol Basic course

We will be hosting a Basic Pistol Shooting course . The NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting is intended for all individuals regardless of previous shooting experience or NRA-affiliation and is available for delivery in two ways. One option is the traditional, instructor-led course where you will receive direct instruction from an NRA-certified instructor from beginning to end. The other option has two components: a self-study or "eLearning module" which is completed online in your own timeframe and a hands-on practical portion conducted in a classroom and shooting range with an Instructor. 16 Jan. USPSA (United States Practical Shooting Association) Pistol Match

Practical Shooting measures the shooter's ability to shoot rapidly and accurately through obstacle-laden courses. The shooter moves, negotiates, runs, covers, and speed reloads through the stage as fast as their skill will allow. If this fast paced shooting sounds like fun, come out and give it a try. Show up with an unloaded centerfire pistol in .38, 9mm, .40, or .45 in an enclosed case and ask a match official where the safe area is so you can holster your gun safely. Also bring a rigid holster, magazines, and mag pouches capable of holding at least 32 rounds. Overall match round counts are usually between 100 and 150 rounds. Specific division requirements can be found at http://uspsa.org. Starts at 9:30 AM. Cost will be \$20 (\$15 for Pinetucky members, active duty military, police, and fire).

23 Jan. The NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting course

Course topics include: gun safety rules, proper operation of revolvers and semi-automatic pistols, ammunition knowledge and selection, pistol selection and storage, shooting fundamentals, pistol inspection and maintenance, marksmanship, and shooting range safety. Additionally, students will complete live fire training and a nationally standardized shooting qualification while on the range with an NRA Certified Instructor. Students will receive the NRA Guide: Basics of Pistol Shooting hand book, take a Basics of Pistol Shooting Student Examination, and receive a course completion certificate bearing the signature of the NRA Secretary and your NRA Certified Instructor.
