Just a reminder, if you use the ranges or fields after hours, please make sure you are signing in on the after-hours sign in sheet. They are located on the rifle/pistol ranges and in low house two on the skeet/trap fields. Also make sure you are cleaning up and locking up when you leave. Members are responsible for cleaning up their brass/shells from their shooting area and locking the gate or houses after shooting. Also remember to pull in target stands when finished. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter, it helps to keep your club clean and neat.
