



CONDITIONS OF USE

- 1) Water sports are considered an extreme sport and as of such come with inherent risks. All these risks will be explained at a safety briefing prior to your exploration should the client request it. Person's taking part in any water sports activity provided by Sea Explorers are required to read and understand this document. After that, the exploration is carried out at the hirers own risk. By signing, you are accepting that you have read and understood all of the information and risks associated with your chosen water based activity.
- 2) Only persons of the age of eighteen may hire and are responsible for both, Individuals, the age restrictions and Sea Explorers equipment.
- 3) Recommended minimum age of solo use is 14 (fourteen).
- 4) It is understood that Sea Explorers offer "BUOYANCY AIDS" And not "Life Jackets". (Observe item 12 and ability to swim)
- 5) Strictly no alcohol or non prescription drugs are to be consumed before or during the activity. If any member of the Sea Explorers team believe that you are under the influence of any mind altering substance, you will not be permitted to take part in any activities.
- 6) Any damage or loss of equipment will render the hirer liable for the subsequent cost of repair or replacement.



- 7) Sea Explorers reserve the right to withdraw the equipment at any stage during the hire period if they consider the hirer's actions contravene the hire agreement, or endanger other users or beach/sea occupants.
- 8) A single hire period is restricted to an hour for all equipment, With the option to extend to two hours maximum. Optimum safe exploration zones will be explained which must be adhered to, unless otherwise agreed.
- 9) Any additional time taken by the hirer to that of the hire period booked will be rounded up to the next full hour and is chargeable. (Delays on the return of equipment effect other users).
- 10) It is the responsibility of the individual hirer to ensure all equipment is returned to the hire point.
- 11) Sea Explorers are not liable for any injury, damage or loss to individual persons or property however incurred. This includes the borrowed use of waterproof phone cases.
- 12) All existing health issues that may affect you taking part in these water sport activities must be reported to Sea Explorers staff prior to taking part and noted in the appropriate section of this disclaimer (e.g.Heart problems, asthma, Diabetes and Allergies). I confirm that we are physically fit and mentally capable to participate in this activity and can swim a minimum of 20 meters unaided.
