

March Speaker: Luis M. Ortiz Jordan B.S., M.S.E.M.



Luis has been growing orchids for over 20 years since the age of 12. He first discovered his love for orchids when his grandfather gifted him his first Cattleya, *Cattleya damiana*, when it bloomed, he was infected with the orchidholic virus. Luis has a mixed collection of orchids, but his passion lays in cool growing miniatures. Luis has multiple AOS awards, in April 2021 he published a paper on an orchid he discovered in Puerto Rico, *Eurystyles luisortizii*. Luis is currently a research scientist at the UF-Scripps Biomedical Research and President of the Orchid Society of the Palm Beaches. **Topic**: Orchids of Puerto Rico.

Editor's Notes

We will have available full-size flyers for you to take, and distribute to any businesses, offices, etc., if they are willing to allow them to be displayed on a front window or bulletin board. From experience, we know Publix and other corporations will not allow things to be posted on their windows from outside organizations, but more local places like convenient stores and sandwich shops are typically happy to support local events. Let us do our best to get the word out around the county.

On Thursday, April 25th, we will need a few people to help to set up smaller tents for our donation and raffle tents, and a couple of folks to put tablecloths on the tables in the main tent (after the big tent is set up). We will

not know the approximate time of the big tent until Wednesday). On Friday, we would like to see helpers for vendors, to show them what area they are assigned in the park and help unpack them if they need it. We will also be asking for members to devote some time at the various tables we set up. The locations will be donation and raffle tent tables. We had plenty of great crews at the tables last year, and we would love to continue that trend. In addition, we will need folks to do the usual yard activities such as checking on the vendors to see if they need something to drink or a break for food or the restroom or to help our visitors throughout the weekend. Sign-up sheets will be available at the meeting.

Also, on Saturday morning, we will need folks to volunteer as clerks to help with the judges. Clerking is a fun, and sometimes very educational, experience. You will sometimes be able to hear the judge's discussion and rationale for why they selected one plant over another. Sign Up Sheets will be available at the meeting for our different needs for the show.

We also have another away show to prepare for in Port St Lucie Orchid Society. The locations will be the Polish American Club in Port St Lucie. The address is 343 Prima Vista Blvd, and the Set-up date is Friday, April 5th beginning at 10am. Our display will be a 6-foot round table, so we will need a pretty wide selection to fill the space adequately. If any of you are interested in helping, please join us, or if you have orchids, you have been growing in your yard or greenhouses that you would allow us to use in our display, but cannot make it to setup,

please call Carolyn (321-506-3909) by Wednesday, April 3rd and we will make arrangements to pick it up and deliver it back to you after the show. Port St Lucie has a 2-day show, so teardown will be at the Sunday afternoon closing at 4pm.







Show & Tell from February's Meeting

From the St Augustine Orchid Society Web Page: Signs of spring abound with an abundance of emerging flower spikes and buds. The flush of spring growth will follow soon so plan your repotting program which should begin in earnest this month. The best time to repot is right before the new roots start growing so the plants will reestablish quickly. Watch for signs of mites, particularly on thin leaved orchids like the catasetinae and grammatophyllums, and treat any problems promptly.

Two great sources for information on growing and keeping your orchids healthy are the American Orchid Society Web Page, and the St Augustine Orchid Society Web Page. Both are well organized to make gathering information and research easy for even the most novice user. Both have breakdowns of specific information by species.
