

The Garden Market at Elawa Farm

Opens May 18th | Fridays & Saturdays | 8am - 1pm | thru October

As spring approaches, tiny seedlings begin to fill the greenhouse little by little - snapdragons of all colors, tasty shallots, silver-green eucalyptus and heirloom sweet peas. The greenhouse signifies the start to the growing season while the gardens outside still quietly await warmer days and more sunshine.

Last year at the farm our small but mighty vegetable garden produced over 7,500 pounds of produce from snap peas to potatoes to green beans to arugula. We welcomed our first Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) members last year, and are excited to continue that program this year. Members pick up a weekly box of fresh produce at the farm each Friday for 20 weeks from June through October. Boxes are limited, so please contact us if you are interested in more information.

This spring we will have plants for sale at the market including dahlias, herbs, tomatoes, bell peppers and more. Choose a selection of seedlings to get your home garden up and growing.

Our garden team is thrilled to provide the community with fresh produce grown right here in Lake Forest following organic practices. We look forward to seeing you at the market throughout the season.


