
LAKEWOOD RACQUET REPORT



The Board and Management have listened to your responses from the membership survey. Overall, the club does have a large amount of capital improvements needed. Our five year plan and two year plan will be refined around making the most impactful improvements for our club per our members desires. Over the past 9 years we have reduced our 1.2 million deferred maintenance projects down to nearly \$600,000.

To help kick start our goals for 2021, several members and past members have donated over \$54,000 this month for capital improvements. This is a tremendous help to start our first project for 2021 while we are shut down. The last time our indoor courts were resurfaced was in 1982 and here are some pictures of the current resurfacing project.
