# KEWOOD RACQUET REPORT

#### LETTER FROM THE MANAGER

Dear Members,

On Friday, October 20th at 5:30pm, the Board held a Membership Meeting. The goal of this meeting was to shed light and bring transparency to the members of the current issues LRC is facing.

The first of these issues was 2024 Financial issues. In late August, the Department of Health informed us of long standing noncompliance issues with our pool, spa, and barrier infrastructure. These issues had not previously been made known to the Board nor to myself. To reopen our pool, we must bring all pool components into compliance with Pierce County pool codes. Preliminary estimates to update, change, and revise things like our filters, our pool drainage system, our heaters, our pumps, the fencing, and a new access path to the outdoor courts, are in the range of \$65k to \$100k. In addition, we have been informed that we need to have a lifeguard present during all hours the pool is open. These costs were not anticipated and cannot be absorbed in the 2024 budget without a significant infusion of new cash. We have a few options available for solving this, but it seems this has become very polarizing. I have included a link to a survey at the end of this letter. This survey will help us better understand how you, the members, feel we should solve this. LRC very rarely sends out surveys, but we feel this issue warrants member input. Going forward if we do issue a survey, it will always come directly from me or the Board. If you have any additional ideas, feel free to email me for further discussion.

Following the pool discussion, we delved into budget issues. As cost of operations are rising and our membership base is declining, the 2024 budget cannot be balanced without closing the pool or obtaining additional funding. By derring several major maintenance items and potentially closing the pool, the budget would be balanced; however, we need to make efforts to improve our long-term financial stability. Since 2014, our membership numbers have been trickling down (from 290 to 220). At this time, we are needing additional members and putting forth recruitment efforts. We also need to find ways to raise additional revenue internally. The efforts include standing court reservations, raising dues above annual CPI increase, donations, etc.

Recently, we have transformed our Pickleball membership. Pickleball is an integral part of our community and we welcome it with open arms. As Pickleball is a growing sport, we see so much potential for new members and a new addition to our community. The Board heard the feedback of LRC Pickleball members following our initial membership proposal to them and redid this proposal. Our current Pickleball membership pricing is now reflective and competitive in the Pickleball community. To become more inclusive to their larger community, we have added Pickleball lessons and Pickleball Skills and Drills. I am so excited to see how this membership takes off.

Our meeting was recorded via Zoom (although the audio is not great-going forward, we will have a microphone, webcam showing the full room, and ensure that only one person speaks at a time).
