



If the corporation wants to install charging stations...

OPTION 1 - No vote by owners if

- 1. the cost of the installation is not greater than 10% of the annual budget;
- 2. the installation of the charging station would not cause a material reduction or elimination of the use or enjoyment of units or of common elements or assets of the corporation; AND
- 3. the corporation provides a 60-day notice to owners.



If the corporation wants to install charging stations...

OPTION 2 - Possible vote by owners

- Corporation provides a notice to owners of its intention to install charging stations and specifically advises them of their right to requisition a meeting of owners to vote on the issue;
- The corporation would be able to proceed with the installation of the charging station only:
 - a) if the owners do not requisition a meeting within 60 days of the notice;
 - b) if a meeting is requisitioned and quorum has not been met;
 - c) if quorum has been met, the owners do not vote against the proposed installation.
