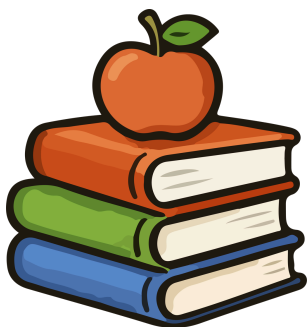


PUSD APPROVED!

02/13/26

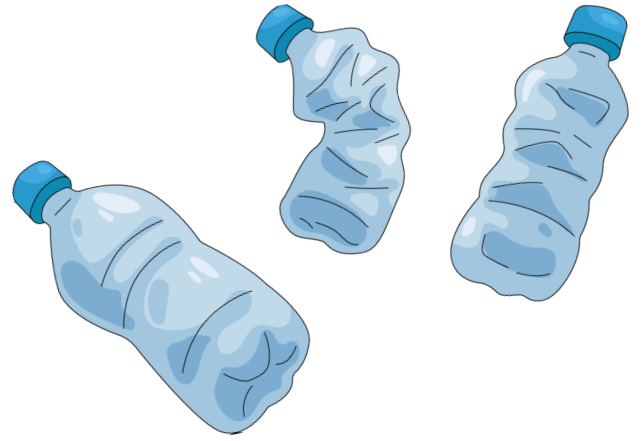
BRIGHT Alliance held its very first meeting for founding officers, marking the official beginning of our journey!

During this meeting, officers introduced themselves, discussed goals, and set expectations for the year ahead. It was an exciting first step toward creating meaningful impact in the community.



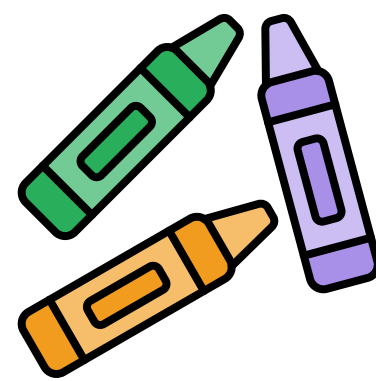
BOTTLE SORT & DONATION

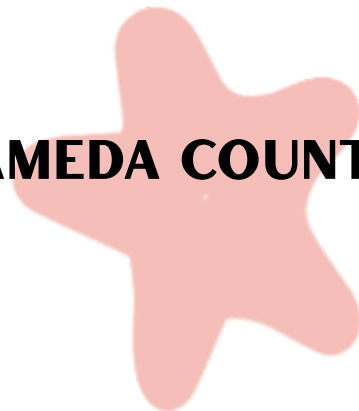
