





3 Grooming Tips for Guys



Tame Brows and Facial Hair

- Brush brows upward with a clean spoolie or clear brow gel to look neat but natural.
- Trim stray hairs around your beard or mustache a day or two before your session for a crisp shape (not right before, to avoid redness).



Blot, Don't Wipe

- Carry blotting sheets or oil-absorbing powder if you get shiny.
- Pat gently on oily areas like the forehead and nose—it keeps skin looking fresh without wiping away your natural skin tone or any light coverage you're wearing.

Hydrate Your Lips

- Chapped lips show up clearly in portraits.
- Exfoliate gently with a damp washcloth, then apply lip balm.
 Matte or non-glossy balms are great for guys who want a natural look.

Beauty Tips for Girls



Heatless Curls Overnight

- Wrap damp hair in silk rollers of braid it before bed.
- Wake up with effortless waves—no heat damage, plus loads of volume for portraits.

The Glow-I In Moisturizer Hack



- Mix a drop of liquid highlighter into your daily moisturizer.
- Gives a natural, dewy glow that looks amazing in photos without heavy shimmer.

Skin Tint > Heavy Foundation



- Seniors are swapping thick foundations for lightweight skin tints.
- Evens out skin tone, feels weightless, and lets your real skin shine through perfect for high-res photos.



Soft Lips instead of harsh lip lines

- Apply a creamy lip tint or lipstick to the center of your lips.
- Use your fingertip or a brush to gently blend the color outward toward the edges, leaving the outer lip line softer.

Brow Gel = Instant Polish



- Clear or tinted brow gel shapes and holds your brows in place all day.
- Just a quick swipe can totally lift your face and make you look more put-together (without looking overdone).

Soft Glam Eyes



- 2025 trend: minimal eye makeup with a
- Curl lashes and use brown mascara instead of black for a softer, youthful vibe.

Trust Your Photographer

 Relax and let your photographer guide your poses. You don't have to know how to "model." A good photographer will help you look natural and confident.


Bring Comfort Items or Your Best Friend
