

Dear Fish Bait Praying & Ministry Partners,

All too soon three months have gone by, and my privilege it is to bring you a summary report from our family and ministry of the Lord's workings in, with, through, and for us, in sincere appreciation of your

prayers and your kind support.

The Lord's hands have been gracious upon us, caring for us in the face of scarcity and harsh economic conditions. Nevertheless, Phebe and I have experienced health challenges induced by allergies. A week after her December 1st birthday, Phebe

was almost hospitalized for fever and breathing difficulty caused by severe catarrh. Earlier that same week, I had a near-fatal motor accident and was also almost hospitalized due to severe allergies and infection. By God's grace, Phebe has recovered enough to complete the academic year. Martha is resilient to all of these. I am still struggling with vocal volatility and allergies. Otherwise, we are all doing well. God is good!

If all our pledged support were redeemed, that should give us about 52% of our estimated need. But we receive an average of about 48%. We very much appreciate our friends and pastors who lead their

churches to pray with us and to sacrifice their widow's mites for us in a time of global difficulty to make sure that our needs are provided for. God bless you! For the year 2022, I set myself three major prayer needs for which we needed the Lord's intervention. We prayed for increased or full family and ministry financial support; we prayed for a piece of land for TRBC, and we prayed to officially inaugurate TRBC.

TOP PRAYERS FOR THE YEAR 2023

- 1. Launch at least one new outreach work
- 2. The Lord's provision of full monthly support for the family and ministry.
- 3. The Lord's provision for a piece of land for This Rock Baptist Church and a new outreach (Glory Baptist Church)
- 4. Vision 2032 10 new churches

We are grateful that the Lord through your prayers and support answered the third need with its associated expansion in our meeting space (from 15x15ft to 15x30ft to 15x 60ft, construction of washrooms, and baptisms. Praise The Lord!

On the national front, just like in most parts of the world, in just a couple of weeks, we moved from a single-digit inflation to about 45%. Gas prices went up by over 200% (now taking a slow decline), together with an unprecedented fall of the value of the local currency to the US dollar by about 250% (also now taking a steady decline), causing a piercing sporadic and uncomfortable rise in the cost of living. We are now in the harmattan season. The resulting dried, humid, and dusty weather conditions have worsened my chronic health problem of bronchitis and rhinitis resulting in painful coughs, fluid, and catarrh with frequent loss of voice.

URGENT NEED

Praying for a speedy provision of about \$30,000 to acquire a piece of land for TRBC and another \$8,000 for land in the next community we pray to reach.

GHANA BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL INSTITUTE (GBTI)

It was a struggle for most of the semester teaching at the Bible institute with a draining voice. But God gave grace, and we ended the semester successfully. All but one of the ten (10) students in both programs did well. I look forward to a new semester in a few days.

CHURCH PLANTING WORK: THIS ROCK BAPTIST CHURCH (TRBC)

Besides our weekday evangelistic drives, we all go out on the last Sundays of every month, after Sunday school, to share the Gospel. Over 400 Gospel literature went out; over 100 souls were presented with the Gospel, and some 16 persons got saved. The common problem is that just about everyone is linked to a Church and leaving those churches which give them no Gospel is a difficulty. Presently about 65 persons come to Church, distributed into 35 youth and adults and 30 adolescents and children. But we get an average of 45 in attendance. There is great excitement at Hope Bible Club, although the numbers have seen some decline.

At the December 31st watch night service we had 9 visitors; two of them were there for the first time. Praying that the Lord brings them back with us.

SPACE is our greatest challenge. We hold three Sunday school classes all in our 15x60 feet space, (and Martha makes a lot of joyful noise with her about 25 children, singing☉.) If the Lord provides about \$30,000, we should acquire a piece of land and start developing it with the hope of being able to move in before 2023 is over and we have to pay rent again. Another \$8,000 will help us buy a piece of land in the next community we pray to start a new work in 2023 (note: the figures keep changing because of changes in the exchange rate). Another need is for dynamic and committed young men whom we can train to lead the services and the discipleship programs.

OTHER MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

I also had several ministering opportunities with other churches and at revival meetings. I continue to enjoy

the opportunity to preach the Gospel to over 400 children and staff of Phebe's school. The greatest of the opportunities this quarter was to spend the whole of the last week of the year at a camp with some 45 adolescents and youth as the guest speaker. The children were drawn from various churches by the Biblefest club with the purpose to challenge them to love the Lord God.

Ebenezer! Thank you very much and God bless you for your ministry of prayer with us!!

- Praying to publish a new book and republish the first


