When I first entered Seminary, the degree I was originally pursuing was "Pastoral Care and Counseling." I wasn't sure if I was going to be a Chaplain or perhaps provided Christian Counseling. Over the years in Seminary and through Field Education opportunities, God helped me clarify my call as an Elder and I switched my major to a Masters in Divinity. Debi is a dedicated volunteer who not only helps coordinate our Health and Wellness Committee with Cathy Dubois but also has helped me lead bible studies and visit those who are in the hospital or are recovering from illness or surgery. Debi went to Garrett Evangelical Theological Seminary and served in the Northern Illinois Conference before transitioning back to working as a nurse. She joined Grace UMC in 2023 after returning to Illinois from Arizona. Debi has graciously offered to help me in any way I discern is a best use of her gifts. I am excited to have Debi to help with caring for our congregation.

In the coming months, we are also looking to create a "Carry the Light" ministry here at Grace. If you are interested in being a part of our visitation ministry and extending our church to those that cannot get out to church, please let Pastor Laura know. 
